Helpful Information

1. All athletes must have a current sports physical on file at school before they will be allowed to participate. Most students get them the summer before 7th grade and the summer before 10th grade. Please call early (mid-spring) to schedule your appointment with your doctor so you do not have to miss practice.
2. Registration for athletics and activities takes place online. For some sports or clubs, there are no activity fees, however, students must still be registered.
 - a. Visit www.cathedralcrusaders.org/online-registration
 - b. Registration is not complete until you are able to view your receipt.
 - c. If you need financial aid, to make payments or to pay by cash/check, please register your student for “Special Consideration” under the appropriate heading. Finances will be discussed between you and the Activities Office once your student has been registered for “Special Consideration”.
3. Season passes to sporting events for high school soccer, volleyball, swimming and basketball. Information regarding passes will be available in August. Ticket prices are \$7 for adults and \$5 for students/seniors.
4. Transportation to practices is available for all 7th/8th grade sports. In some instances, a bus for high school sport practices is available at an additional cost.
